This course will give you skills that you can apply in retail nurseries, properties, parks, gardens and nature reserves.



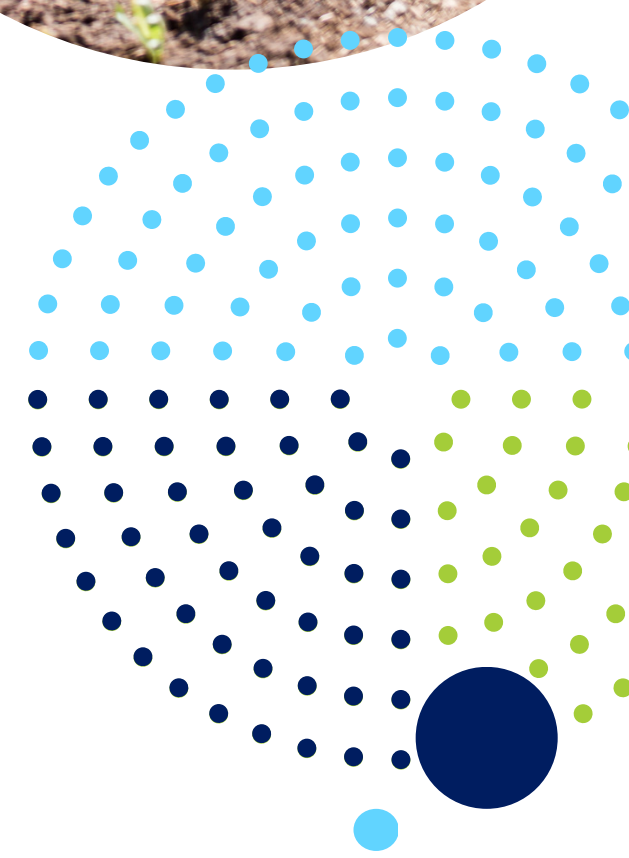

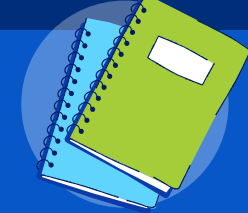

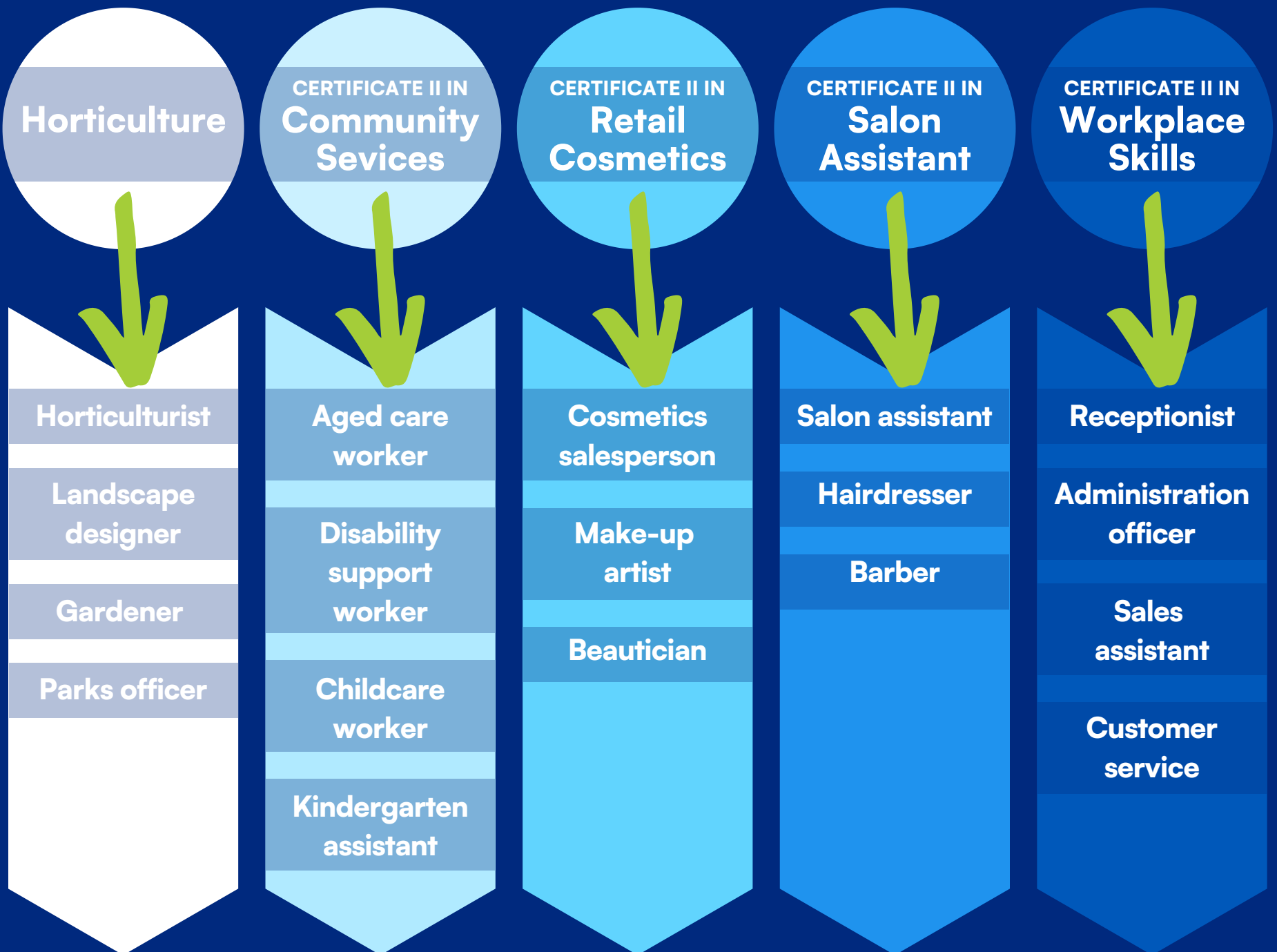
