## PAYMENT METHODS

Drouin Secondary College will use Compass Pay to collect monies for all contributions. Compass records accurately the contributions that families will make. So that we can accurately track the payment that you make, in the event of a family requiring a refund, we strongly recommend that you use this method to make all your payments to the College.

## REFUNDS

Parent requests for refunds are subject to the discretion of the school and made on a case-by-case basis. Refunds will be provided where the school deems it is reasonable and fair to do so, taking into consideration whether a cost has been incurred, the Department's Parent Payment Policy and Guidance, Financial Help for Families Policy, and any other relevant information.

### **Curriculum and Other Contributions.**

- Fully refundable if paid in the preceding year and the student does not commence at the College, and any items are returned in the condition with which they were supplied
- Pro-rata will be considered, based on Compass records

### **Extra-Curricular Items and Activities**

- Fully refundable if paid in the preceding year and the student does not commence at the College on a case-by-case basis (dependent upon costs already expended by the College and reason for refund)
