About the Course: The Sport, Aquatics and Recreation program provides students the opportunity to acquire and develop the skills, knowledge and confidence to work in the areas of sport and outdoor recreation related industries. Leadership, organisational and specialist activity skills will be developed through the units of competency undertaken in the selected program. The second year of the course is also a scored Unit 3 & 4 VCE subject.

Program Length: 2 years - Commencement of program will depend on adequate numbers for enrolment

- To provide participants with the knowledge and skills to achieve units of competence that will enhance their employment prospects in sport, aquatics, fitness and recreation or related industries.
